



## KYOCERA NIXKA INKJET SYSTEMS (KNIS) WILL BE PRESENT AT DRUPA 2024 IN DUSSELDORF

KNIS will exhibit its newly launched water based inkjet print engines dedicated to industrial players.

**Aubagne, France, March 20, 2024:** Kyocera Nixka is pleased to announce its participation to drupa 2024, which will take place in Dusseldorf, Germany between May 28 and June 7. We will be present on the Kyocera Corporation booth Hall 10 A11 with all our products, but also Hall 8A C20 on the Kyocera Document Solutions booth with a dedicated KNIS corner to introduce our products.

Visitors will be able to see our GENIX 1200 print engine, able to address full color or monochrome applications with a all-in-one PrinBox concept. The system can print 1200x1200dpi native with a grayscale mode up to 100m/min or 1200x600dpi up to 200m/min on a 108mm print width. With its embedded cleaning station, the system is easy to integrate, easy to use and easy to maintain, well designed for industrial applications such as decoration or personalization of paper, tissue or flexible packaging.

Our last LENIX 1200 print engine for wider print width in monochrome or full color will also be visible. LENIX has the same resolution and speed than GENIX, and can propose print width from 216mm to 866mm with a single PrintBar. It is a modular and scalable print engine adapted to packaging, publishing or other markets requiring high quality digital printing with water based inks.

Both systems are using the last Kyocera KJ4B-EX1200-RC printhead from our mother company enabling ink recirculation for a wider range of application and fewer maintenance operations.
